3. Events

The 2010 Autotech Services ACT Regional Rally Series shall comprise of eight (8) provisional rounds contested over the following one (1) day events (except where indicated). Changes to event names, formats and dates can and do happen throughout the year. Therefore where applicable; the new date advised by the event organiser will apply to the relevant event as part of the 2010 Autotech Services ACT Regional Rally Series. Should the situation arise, the ACT Series Committee may allow a substitute event if the ACT Series Committee deem it necessary. The dates and names are correct at time of print:

- a) In keeping with the NSW Clubman competition conditions, the maximum entry fee will be \$355.00, which will include an ACT Series administration fee of \$12.00 per ACT Series registered vehicle payable to the '**ACT Regional Rally Series**' by event organisers.
- b) The scheduled competitive distance will be a minimum of 100kms, although Event Organisers are strongly encouraged to provide greater than the minimum scheduled distance.
- c) In the case of part or parts of an event being deleted due to weather or force majeure, as long as a minimum of 50% of the special stage distance has been included in results, then the event will be deemed a valid round.
- d) Competitors will be required to meet the relevant apparel requirements for each individual event as per the specific event's Supplementary Regulations.

4. Registration

Categories:

Gold Cup	Championship category of the ACT Series.
Clubman	Intermediate category of the ACT Series.
Novice	Introductory category of the ACT Series.
Silver Cup	Dedicated to 2WD vehicles including club, classic
Classic	Popular category for classic and historic vehicles.

- a) **All drivers and co-drivers wishing to score points in the ACT Series must be registered with the ACT Series Committee seven (7) days prior to the day of the first event in which they wish to score points.** It should be noted that Event Organisers are not permitted to accept registrations.
- b) The cost of registration is \$30.00 per person per category for Gold Cup and Clubman categories, and an additional \$15.00 each if competitors wish to be considered for the Silver Cup or Classic category. Novice registrations do not attract a fee this year. However, Novice competitors wanting to register for other categories must pay the appropriate fee for those categories.
- c) Registrations will only be accepted online via the BMSC website (www.bmsc.com.au) subject to clause 4(a). Payments for those using this method will be accepted by credit card only. Paper registrations will not be accepted in order to maximise the benefits of the online registration process.

- d) The Co-Efficient List, as outlined in clause 13, is issued by the ACT Series Committee for the 2010 Autotech Services ACT Regional Rally Series in January 2010 and is the only co-efficient list to be used to determine a driver's eligibility for each category for 2010 (this list is provided courtesy of www.nswrally.com). Drivers with a co-efficient of above and including 0.90 will be considered Gold Cup. Drivers with a co-efficient of below 0.90, and all co-drivers, may nominate to enter any category but such nomination will be subject to the acceptance of the ACT Series Committee. Any such decision by the ACT Series Committee will be final and can not be appealed. Competitors may register in multiple categories subject to eligibility.
- e) Entrants electing to compete in the Silver Cup or Classic must also register with the ACT Series Committee as Gold Cup, Clubman or Novice competitors.
- f) Drivers who have been placed in the top three driver positions in any prior State or State Clubman Series will not be eligible to register for ACT Clubman or ACT Novice categories. The ACT is not considered a State for purposes of this clause.
- g) Drivers who have been placed 1st outright in the Clubman Driver category of any previous ACT Series will not be eligible to register for ACT Clubman or ACT Novice categories.
- h) To be eligible for the Novice Driver category, entrants must:
- i. Not have been classified as a finisher, when driving, in more than 3 special stage rally events prior to 31 December 2009,
 - ii. Not have started more than 5 special stage rallies as a driver prior to 31 December 2009.
- i) Drivers who have been placed 1st outright in the Novice Driver category of any previous ACT Series will not be eligible to register for the ACT Novice category.

5. Point score

- a) The ACT Series will be made up of eight (8) provisional rounds with an entrant's highest scoring six (6) events counting towards the championship/category point score. In the event that only seven (7) provisional rounds are successfully conducted, an entrant's highest scoring six (6) rounds will count towards the championship/category. In the event that only six (6) provisional rounds are successfully conducted, an entrant's highest scoring five (5) rounds will count towards the championship/category. Should less than six (6) provisional rounds be successfully conducted, then all rounds will count towards the championship/category.
- b) All registered competitors must display the relevant sponsor advertising clearly displayed on each side of their competing vehicle prior to the start of each event to score their relevant points. Failure to do so will result in no points being scored for the event (further details are outlined in clause 6).
- c) The ACT Series will comprise of five (5) categories – Gold Cup, Clubman, Novice, Silver Cup, and Classic.
- d) Points may only be scored as driver or co-driver in each rally and the competitor must compete only as a driver or co-driver in an event (i.e. drivers and co-drivers may not swap roles during a rally).
- e) Points will be awarded as follows in each category:
- Starting 1 point,
 - Finishing 1 point,
 - 1st to 10th in each category 20,15,12,10,8,6,4,3,2,1 respectively.

- f) Registrations for 2010 ACT Series will open with the release of these competition conditions, and close midnight 30th September 2010.
- g) For rounds that are conducted over more than one (1) day, you must complete the entire event in order to score ACT Series points. That is, if you restart under the event 'superally' rules (should they apply) you are ineligible to score ACT Series placing points in any categories for which you may be registered. You will be deemed 'Did Not Finish (DNF)' for the purposes of scoring points.
- h) In the event of a tied point score at the conclusion of the ACT Series, the tied competitors scores will be compared after dropping their best scoring round and the higher resulting score shall be deemed to take the higher placing. Should a tie still occur then the process will be repeated and so on until the tie is broken. If the tie cannot be broken by the above method then the competitors will be awarded equal placing.
- i) Co-drivers are not required to compete with a registered driver, but will only be eligible to score points in the categories in which the driver would be eligible. Co-drivers will only be awarded points in their registered category. This category cannot be lower than that of their driver e.g. a Clubman co-driver will not score points while co-driving for a Gold Cup driver. Where it is unclear what category an unregistered driver may or may not be eligible for, clarification should be sought from the ACT Series Committee prior to the close of entries for the relevant event. The ACT Series Committee will utilise the Co-efficient Seeding List in clause 13 to determine the driver's 'category' qualification.
- j) Should an ACT Series event elect to run the Classic category at the front of the field, preceding competitors of the main event, then Classic registered competitors that choose to run as such will only be able to score points in the Classic Category. They will not be eligible for points in any other registered category (i.e. Gold Cup, Clubman, Novice, or Silver Cup). Classic registered competitors that choose to be seeded within competitors of the main event will not suffer such a penalty.
- k) During the year each registered competitor in the ACT Series has the option to act as an official (e.g. control, road closure, course car, director, chief scrutineer) for one event.
- i. For one event each competitor, upon proof of involvement as an official, will score 22 points towards each category for which they are registered.
 - ii. Competitors who are entered and compete in a particular event cannot score points as a result of officiating at the same event.
 - iii. Assisting the Chief Scrutineer at scrutineering will not be considered officiating for the purpose of this clause.
 - iv. Proof of involvement will consist of the submission to the ACT Series Committee of the **"Confirmation of Officiating"** form enclosed in these regulations duly signed by any one of the following for the event:
 - Clerk of Course,
 - Assistant Clerk of Course,
 - Event Secretary,
 - Stage Commander
 - v. **It is the registered competitor's responsibility to obtain and mail a completed "Confirmation of Officiating" form to the ACT Series Committee to the official address noted in clause 11 within fourteen (14) days of the conclusion of the event for which they are claiming officiating points. Points will not be awarded if this condition is not met.**
 - vi. If total points scored in a category at the end of the year are only scored through officiating, those points become null and void.

- l) Should competitors be tied for a placing in an ACT Series category in an event, each tied competitor will be awarded the points applicable to the placing covered by the tie. The next placed entrant following the tied entrants will receive the next applicable place points:
 - i. Example 1: Two competitors tie for 2nd Gold Cup driver; each will receive the 2nd placed points i.e. 17 points. Next placed entrant receives the 4th place points. In this example that would be 12 points.
 - ii. Example 2: Four competitors tie for 3rd Silver Cup co-driver each will receive the 3rd placed points i.e. 14 points. Next placed entrant receives 7th place points, which in this example would be 6 points.

6. ACT Series Sponsors

- a) The ACT Series sponsors will receive complementary registration for only one (1) category for one (1) driver and one (1) co-driver. All other ACT Series conditions apply.
- b) The naming rights ACT Series sponsor for the 2010 ACT Regional Rally Series is Autotech Services. It is mandatory for all registered competitors to have advertising supplied by the ACT Series Committee, applied in a prominent position to front guards and/or front doors of the competing vehicle. **Failure to have such advertising displayed at all times during an event will automatically results in the loss of any points scored by the registered driver and co-driver of the offending vehicle in that event.**
 - i. It is the competitor's responsibility to ensure that such advertising is displayed as noted. Advertising that is lost during an event due to accident damage or other reason will not incur loss of points providing it is the ACT Series Committee's joint opinion that such damage/loss is genuine.
 - ii. Stickers may be placed in a prominent position elsewhere on the vehicle providing that a request is put to the ACT Series Committee in writing and received at the **official address** of the ACT Series Committee within 14 days prior to the event for which they are wishing to score points.
 - iii. ACT Series Committee members will make every effort to ensure they carry stickers with them at all rounds of the ACT Series.
- c) It will also be recognised that the Novice Driver and Co-Driver categories are sponsored by Carco Exhaust and Automotive. It is therefore mandatory for all registered Novice competitors to have the ACT Series naming rights sponsor advertising supplied by the ACT Series Committee, applied in a prominent position on their vehicle. **Failure to have such advertising displayed at all times during an event will automatically results in the loss of any Novice points scored by the registered driver and co-driver of the offending vehicle in that event.**
- d) Should advertising concerning an ACT Series sponsor potentially conflict with advertising already displayed by an ACT Series competitor, such competitor must notify the ACT Series Committee in writing no later than **14 days prior to the first event** that the conflicting advertising will be displayed. Taking into consideration all of the information supplied by the competitor, the ACT Series Committee will advise the competitor whether an actual conflict does exist and what action should be taken by the competitor to remedy such conflict. The ACT Series Committee's decision on this matter shall be taken as final with any competitor not complying with such direction precluded from receiving any points in the event in question.

7. Vehicle Eligibility

Gold Cup Vehicles must comply with the general requirements for vehicles in FIA Group A, N, PRC, Group N(P), or CAMS recognised classic and club rally cars.

<i>Clubman</i>	Vehicles must comply with the general requirements for vehicles in FIA group A, N, PRC, or CAMS recognised classic rally cars. Vehicles classified as in classes P5, N4, or N(P) are not eligible to enter the Clubman series.
<i>Novice</i>	Vehicles must not be turbo charged 4WD. Naturally aspirated 4WD IS eligible. Turbo 2WD IS eligible. Vehicles must comply with the general requirements for vehicles in FIA Group A, N, PRC, or CAMS recognised classic rally cars.
<i>Silver Cup</i>	Vehicles must be 2wd. Vehicles must comply with the general requirements for vehicles in FIA Group A, N or PRC, or CAMS recognised classic and club rally cars.
<i>Classic</i>	Vehicles must comply with the Classic Rally Car regulations of the 2010 CAMS manual.

8. Awards

<i>Novice</i>	1st \$250.00 + trophy + the perpetual Novice Trophy *
<i>Silver Cup</i>	1st \$250.00 + trophy + the perpetual Silver Cup *
<i>Classic</i>	1st trophy + perpetual Classic Trophy *

<i>Gold Cup</i>	1st \$200.00 + 12.5% of the prize pool + Trophy 2nd 7.5% of the prize pool + Trophy 3rd 5% of the prize pool + Trophy
<i>Clubman</i>	1st \$200.00 + 12.5% of the prize pool + Trophy 2nd 7.5% of the prize pool + Trophy 3rd 5% of the prize pool + Trophy
<i>Novice</i>	1st \$250.00+ Trophy
<i>Silver Cup</i>	1st \$250.00+ Trophy
<i>Classic</i>	1st Trophy

9. Disqualification

Should a competitor be excluded by the stewards from any round of the ACT Series, the point awarded for starting the event will be forfeited. The competitor (driver and co-driver) will score 0 points for that event.

10. Disclaimer

The ACT Series Competition Conditions have been written in good faith. The ACT Series Committee reserves discretionary power over all clauses herein. Competitors should address written protests to the ACT Series Committee. Individual circumstances will be considered.

If you would like to suggest changes to the ACT Series Competition Conditions for subsequent years, you can forward a submission to the ACT Series Committee which must be received at the official email address (refer to clause 11), the official postal address, or both.

Submissions may not be forwarded via any other means; those that are will be ignored. Your submission should be clear, relatively concise and considered. Please be aware that the ACT Series Committee may ask you to attend one of their meetings to discuss your proposal. Where possible the ACT Series Committee will consult competitors on changes to the regulations via email or the private ACT Series forum on www.bmsc.com.au or through their car Clubs.
