



Spectator Instructions: All instructions are from Uriarra Settlement

Spectator Points 1, 4 & 7: Uriarra Forestry Settlement (Start, Service Area and Finish)

The service area is located on the oval in front of the school. The Uriarra Community will have a BBQ at the school. Restrooms are located in the school. Results will be displayed throughout the day. The Uriarra community are very supportive of rallying - please support their BBQ.

Spectator Point 2 & 5 – East West

Turn Left out of the Uriarra Settlement on to Brindabella Road. Turn right at the next T-junction onto Uriarra Road and travel for approximately 1.25km. Turn left onto gravel road (Signposted Mountain Creek Road). Follow road for approximately 1.5 kms. Turn left and go through the gate (Please keep the gate closed). The forest has a 40kph speed limit. Travel up the hill for approximately 1.5kms. –

CAUTION - 2-Way Traffic. Park on the left side of the road. Car 1 is due at approximately 11.15am. The stage is run twice, the cars return at about 2.00pm

Spectator Point 3 & 6 – Cottage 5

Turn Right out of the Uriarra Settlement on to Brindabella Road, follow for approximately 6km and turn right onto Cotter Road. Go over a narrow bridge, past where the Cotter Hotel once stood (the road you are on becomes Paddys River Road at this point) and travel a further 3.3km. Turn right onto gravel road – sign posted “Rally Action”. Follow the road for 200m and park on side of road. The spectator point is approximately 100m further along the road. Car 1 is due at approximately 12.10pm. The stage is run twice, the cars return at about 3.05pm

Do not stop at Laural Camp or Vanity’s Crossing Roads – these are for competitor use only.

There is a gap between Spectator Point 3 and Spectator Point 5 so spectators are advised to return to the Uriarra Forestry Settlement for something to eat and drink and to watch competitors service the cars.

Spectator Point 7 – Mineshaft (an alternative to Spectator Point 6)

Turn Right out of the Uriarra Settlement on to Brindabella Road, follow for approximately 6km and turn right onto Cotter Road. Go over a narrow bridge, past where the Cotter Hotel once stood (the road you are on becomes Paddys River Road at this point) and travel a further 5.5km. Park on Right hand side of road – sign posted “Rally Action”. The spectator point is approximately 100m further off the road. Car 1 is due at approximately 3.05pm. **PLEASE NOTE: The Mineshaft Spectator point will only be used in the afternoon.**

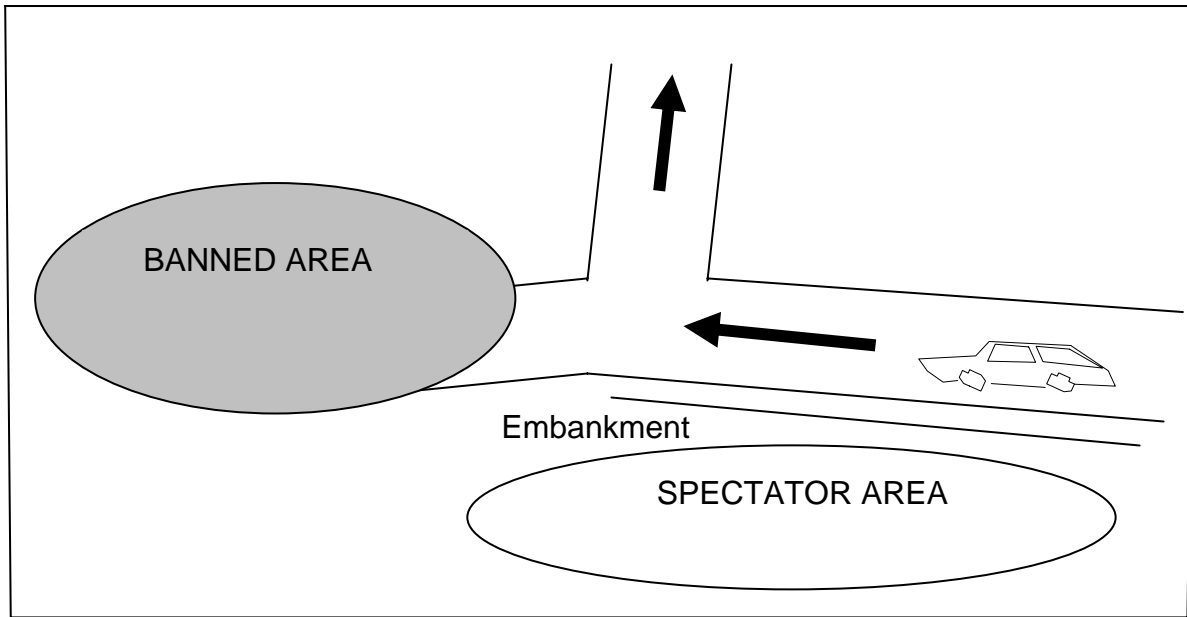

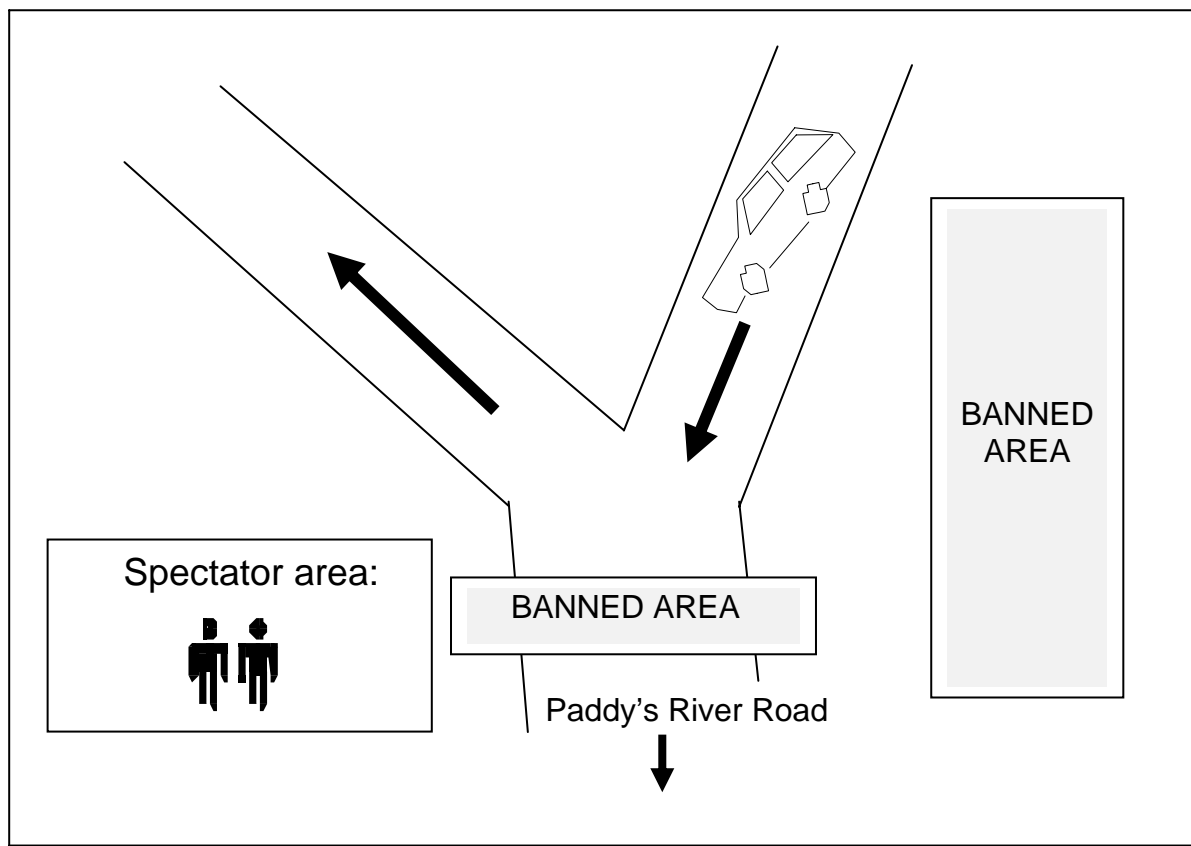
- the risks associated with attending or participating in the event include the risk that you may suffer harm as a result of:

You accept the conditions of, and acknowledge the risks arising from, attending or participating in the event and being provided with the event services by CAMS and the Associated Entities.

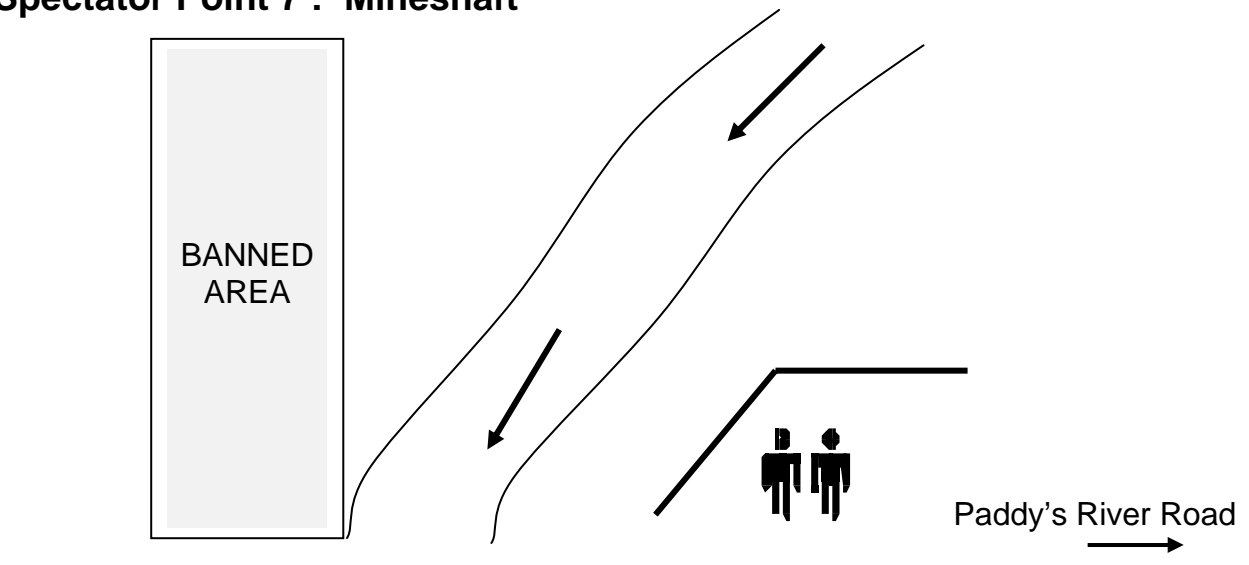
